

General Information

- Children must be 3 years old to attend CHIPS
- AM and PM Sessions offered
 - AM Session- 8:15-10:45
 - PM Session- 12:00-2:30
- Two, three, and four day options
 - Two day sessions are Tuesday/Thursday
 - Three day sessions are Monday/Wednesday/Friday
 - Four day sessions are Monday-Thursday or Tuesday-Friday
 - Four year olds receive priority for four day sessions

Tuition

• Two day program- \$1200/year (can be paid in 10 monthly installments of \$120)

• Three day program- \$1750/year (can be paid in 10 monthly installments of \$175)

• Four day program- \$2300/year (can be paid in 10 monthly installments of \$230)

Highly Qualified Teachers and Staff

Our teachers have Bachelor's Degrees (most have Master's Degrees) and are certified in early childhood education and special education. In addition, our staff includes highly qualified paraprofessionals, speech pathologists, occupational therapists, a physical therapist, a social worker, a BCBA, and a school nurse.

Small Classes

Our classes have a maximum of 15 students with a teacher and at least one paraprofessional.

Integrated, Inclusive Environment

 Inclusive preschool environments have been shown to be beneficial for both students with disabilities and typically developing children.

How to register:

- Complete the CHIPS Pre-registration application, which can be found on our website beginning on 1/31/25. Chelmsford residents receive priority. Non-Chelmsford residents may enroll on a space available basis after pre-registration.
- DO NOT complete the registration paperwork on the Chelmsford Public Schools student registration page at this time. You will be asked to complete this paperwork after you have been offered and accepted a spot at CHIPS.
- You will be notified of acceptance and session after February vacation. (Or on a rolling, space available basis if you pre-register after February)
- A \$10 registration fee and first month's tuition will be required to hold your child's spot.
